The Board met in special session at 6:30 PM. Members present: Chairman, Marc Lindeen, Vice-Chairman, Greg Moeller and Gary See also, Auditor/Secretary to the Board Shelly Barber.

This was an informational meeting held with the residents of the former City of Mt. Union giving them the information that the county has now on the discontinuance of the City of Mt Union on March 8, 2017. They were given the information of what part the State City Development Board has and the role that Henry County has at this point.

They were informed of the difference between levies for them as a corporation and as rural residents which is approximately \$5.25 less per \$1,000 taxable value based on current years rates.

RUSS is working on a new 28E Agreement with Henry County to be approved for assuming the debt owed to RUSS and the USDA that was formerly with of the City of Mt. Union. Then two county Wastewater Ordinances will be published and Public Hearings held reading the Ordinance before adoption, they will state that within a described district the collection of sewer fees will be done by Special Assessment. Next a Resolution that the Henry County Board of Supervisors agree to bridge the funds still owed to RUSS from delinquent sewer fees, so that rates can be adjusted will be approved and another Resolution with RUSS to set the annual sewer fees for the district from July 1, 2017 thru June 30, 2018 will be approved.

They were also informed on the solid waste services and the street services that Henry County will be providing to their community.

Questions were requested from the residents and answered by the county officials.

All questions being answered the meeting was adjourned.
