The Board met in regular session at 9:00 AM. Members present: Chairman, Marc Lindeen, Greg Moeller and Gary See.

It was moved by Moeller and seconded by See to approve the minutes of the August 10, 2017 Supervisors meeting. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Sonja Roth of Wayland stopped in and voiced her concerns on the mobile home park on the edge of Wayland in the county. It has half of the trailers removed and all but one person moved out, the city shut the water off to it and there is a huge pile of garbage and trash that has been there for months, which is what she was wondering if the Supervisors could provide a dumpster and haul it away the city of Wayland agreed to come and load the dumpster for them. Also, she wondered why we don't have an animal shelter in Henry County as she is feeding 20 plus cats every day at that mobile home park.

Jake Hotchkiss, Engineer, accompanied by Jelen McCall, office Manager gave the Secondary Road update. Road maintenance August 7th thru August 13th. Continued shoulder pulling project on Marsh Ave and hauled rock to Marsh Ave to complete the project. Sent boom mower out to cut brush, continued mowing shoulders and set up road signs for detour on H38. Worked on ditching project on 250th St east of Oakland Mills Rd and worked on dirt roads. Placed shouldering rock on south side of Oakland Mills Bridge, continued shouldering on Franklin Ave and worked on resurfacing dead end gravels. Hauled spot rock and removed detour signs late in the afternoon for Oakland Mills Bridge as it opened at 4:00 pm on Friday. Winfield Ave from Iris St to the west to Grand Ave is closed to through traffic, contractor has paved main line section from Grand Ave to Detrick's Truck & Trailer Service and is now working on handwork near Grand Ave. Subcontractor has closed Winfield Ave east of Iris St and is working on placing cross road pipe. The intersection of Iris St will remain open for businesses west of Iris St. A detour Has been set up for Winfield Ave from 220th St then south on Marsh Ave to Hwy 34. The Engineer wants to remind the public that Pilot is entered from Grand Ave and Detrick's Truck & Trailer Service, Liquid-grow, Mini Storage, Pioneer Seeds and East End Automotive are all open for business and have access off Iris St. Oakland Mills Bridge opened to traffic last Friday at 4:00 pm the contractor will be working on punch list items in the future. County crew completed shoulder pull and is now resurfacing Marsh Ave south of Hwy 34 and should be completing this project on Wednesday. County crew will be starting work next week on a shoulder pull project on Benton Ave from the intersection of Agency Rd going north to 250th St approximately 3.5 miles.

It was moved by Moeller and seconded by See to increase the payment per case from \$100 to \$150 for the Medical Examiner and Medical Examiner Investigators. 3 ayes. Motion carried. This is due to Henry, Lee and Des Moines Counties sharing a ME and the other two counties pay \$150 per case.

John Pullis, Conservation Director gave his monthly update. They are getting cost estimates for cabins before making the decision to build, signed contract for propane with B & B at \$1.069 and approved the updated changes to the By Laws.

John Hansen and Mike Adkins from Midwest Construction Consultants presented a proposal for Construction Management Services for the Henry County Law Center & Jail Project. They have built or

done expansions on 30 plus correction facilities in Iowa as this is what they specialize in. He stated they would be the county's representative to get the best facility for the money as they are not contractors.

In sub-committee meetings Moeller attended Great River Regional Housing Trust.

It was moved by Moeller and seconded by See the meeting be adjourned. 3 ayes. Motion carried.
