The Board met in regular session at 9:00 AM. Members present: Chairman, Marc Lindeen, Vice-Chairman, Greg Moeller and Gary See.

It was moved by See and seconded by Moeller to approve the minutes of the May 18, 2017 meeting. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Jake Hotchkiss, Engineer, accompanied by Jelen McCall, Office Manager, gave the Secondary Road update. It was moved by Moeller and seconded by See that the County approve construction plans for territory sheds located at 1208 Franklin Ave, Wayland and 1190 Oasis Ave, Winfield. The letting date is set for June 13, 2017. 3 ayes. Motion carried. The Board Reviewed two self-applied dust control permits. Road maintenance May 15th thru May 19th. Territory operators were in their blades, started pulling shoulders on 335th St from Hwy 218 going east, installed crossroad pipes and replaced entrances along 335th St as they went working on this project most of the week. Started spraying roadsides for weeds, worked on paved road granular shoulders and continued mowing shoulders. Resumed seeding operation in various locations, worked on signs, Grout Scouts started working on lining culverts on New London Rd from Henry-Lee to New London and the county provided traffic control. Hauled resurfacing rock near Wayland and done weed eating around guard rails. Winfield Ave from Iris St to the west to Grand Ave is closed to through traffic, contractor worked on removing pavement and installing storm sewer pipe.

The Board discussed the County auctioning miscellaneous assets of the former City of Mt Union, on Thursday June 8, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. at the former city maintenance building located at 206 S Crew St, Mt Union. Photos of some of the items up for auction have been posted on Henry County's website at www.henrycountyiowa.us. This does not include the real estate property which will be at a later date. The County will also be holding another informational meeting for the community of Mt Union on May 31, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at the Community Building in Mt Union to bring residents up to date on all matters.

In sub-committee meetings Lindeen attended Great River Regional Waste Authority meeting.

It was moved by Moeller and seconded by See the meeting be adjourned. 3 ayes. Motion carried.
