Henry County Transition LINK is looking for a candidate to fill a full-time position as a Community Transition Coordinator. The position involves meeting with incarcerated inmates in the Des Moines, Henry and Louisa County Jails to provide mental health intake screening, administer required assessments, determine needs and facilitate connections to community based services and supports. The program goal is to reduce recidivism among jail inmates with a mental health diagnosis.

The ideal candidate will possess at minimum a Bachelor's Degree in a human service related field from an accredited college or university. A minimum of 2 years of experience in mental health services or case management. The position is subject to criminal history, fingerprints, pre-employment physical and drug screen and adherence to the Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003. Candidate must be able to meet in the jail setting with close contact with male and female inmates. Travel to each county at minimum once per week is required. A valid driver's license and access to a dependable vehicle is required.
