The Board met in regular session at 9:00 AM. Members present: Chairman, Greg Moeller and Marc Lindeen and Gary See.

It was moved by See and seconded by Lindeen to approve the April 3, 2018 Agenda with amendment adding to the agenda Approval of Proclamation of April being Child Abuse Prevention month as posted. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Lindeen and seconded by See to approve the minutes of the March 29, 2018 Supervisors meeting. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Jake Hotchkiss, Engineer, accompanied by Office Manager, Jelen McCall gave the Secondary Road update. Board reviewed 2 sanitary outlet permits in ROW on Marsh Ave and Franklin Ave and 2 utility permits for service to home on Lexington Ave for Access Energy and Oakland Mills Rd for Mt Pleasant Utilities. Road maintenance March 24th to March 30th. Saturday sent 4 trucks out to plow snow in the northern part of the county due to snow and sleet, then again Sunday morning to clear roads in the am only. Territory operators were in their blades all week, hauled spot rock to various locations and hauled resurfacing rock to Baltimore Twp. Removed a large tree on 253rd St east of Oakland Mills brush crews worked on brush removal near Salem and started a ditching project in Salem on Liberty St. Worked on signs and worked on miscellaneous items on small bridges, repaired damaged guardrail on Iowa Ave and sent 4 men to a One Call Meeting in Burlington. 140th St and Dakota Ave grading contractor is working on replacing culverts last week and will continue this week. Bids will be opened Tuesday April 10th on tied culvert project.

Approved liquor license for the Loyal Order of Moose Lodge No. 1003.

Moved by See and seconded by Lindeen to approve Proclamation naming April 2018 as Child Abuse Prevention Month. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Joining the meeting was Ed Longanecker to talk with the Board about the Sheriff Department no longer going to offer the alarm system to private residents and businesses in Henry County. He asked the Board to reconsider their decision on stopping this service and he could see where it could even be a source of income to the county. The Board agreed to speak with Sheriff McNamee about the matter.
