It was moved by Lindeen and seconded by See that right-of-way contracts for purchase of land for Projects LFM-G172823 and LFM-BC173010, 260th St grading and culvert be approved. 3 ayes. Motion carried. It was moved by Lindeen and seconded by See that the county approve construction plans for Projects LFM-G172823 and LFM-BC173010, 260th St grading and culvert. The letting date is set for January 10, 2019. 3 ayes. Motion carried. The Board reviewed a permit for a sanitary outlet on 235th St. Road maintenance November 25th thru November 30th. Sunday sent plow trucks out at 3:00 pm to cover routes to remove some of the snow. It was very tough conditions 7-10 inches of snow. Monday sent plow trucks and Motor graders out at 5:00 am worked on clearing pavements and gravel roads. Tuesday territory operators started at 5:00 am and trucks went out at normal time to continue clearing pavements and gravel roads. Pavements were clear by the end of the work day. Wednesday territory operators started again at 5:00 am and completed initial pass of all gravel roads and then went back to cut openings in snow piles for forecasted rain. Started crews working on cleaning bridges for drainage. Territory operators continued working on opening holes for forecasted rain, worked winging back snow on paved roads with motor grader, worked on iced areas, continued cleaning bridges for drainage. Sent plow trucks out at 5:00 am on Friday morning for wintery mix and cleaned up trucks in the afternoon. Benton Ave culvert waiting on the weather to finish. Gravel road conditions are improving with colder temps we will be spotting rock to various locations as needed the rest of this week. Signed 2 certificates for 25 years of service for Robert Bruggemeyer and Harold Pollmeier.
