The Board met in regular session at 9:00 AM. Members present: Chairman, Greg Moeller, Marc Lindeen and Gary See.

Joining the meeting was Ted Mohrfeld.

It was moved by See and seconded by Lindeen to approve the June 12, 2018 Agenda as presented. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by Lindeen and seconded by See to approve the minutes of the June 7, 2018 Supervisors meeting. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Jake Hotchkiss, Engineer, accompanied by Jelen McCall, Office Manager gave the weekly roads update. The Board reviewed 2 permits for sanitary outlets one on Kentucky Ave and one on Ash Ave. Road maintenance June 4th thru June 8th. Territory operators were in their blades all week, installed a crossroad pipe, completed shoulder pull and hauled rock to Agency Rd. Continued mowing gravel road shoulders, spraying noxious weeds and worked on weed eating around guardrails. Worked on a couple small ditching projects, repaired a tile line on 220th St, repaired an RCP on Mediapolis Rd and started prepping the paint machine. Cedar Falls Construction Co will be working on concrete patches this week on Oasis Ave, Racine Ave and Old Hwy 34. Merrimac Rd shoulder pull project has started and will continue for the next 3 weeks. Set date for Reclassification of road to Level C.

John Pullis, Conservation Director gave his monthly report. French-Reneker is working on cost estimates on moving the Waterworks Campground. They have been planting food plots, therefore not able to work on the new cabins for the last 5 weeks, but are checking various options for ADA compliant showers so the cabins will be fully ADA compliant. Discussed having the Dish Network at the office and shop for weather alerts for the campgrounds since the State Auditors addressed it, not feeling it was necessary, but the Conservation Board is going to vote and approve it next meeting. The Conservation Board approved a Resolution designating individuals Peace Officers for IPERS purposes. Also, they approved the Teachers Guide for FY 18/19 for the Naturalist visits with the schools. Wisdom Quest completed their 23rd annual river cleanup.

Shelly Barber, Auditor & Commissioner of Elections presented the Canvass of the results of the June 5, 2018 Primary Election to the Board for review and approval. It was moved by Lindeen and seconded by See to approve the Canvass as presented. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

No sub-committee meetings.

It was moved by See and seconded by Lindeen the meeting be adjourned. 3 ayes. Motion carried.
