The Board met in regular session at 9:00 AM. Members present: Chairman, Greg Moeller, Gary See and Marc Lindeen was absent.

Joining the meeting was Kat Zeglen.

It was moved by See and seconded by Moeller to approve the June 4, 2019 Agenda as presented. 2 ayes. Motion carried.

It was moved by See and seconded by Moeller to approve the minutes of May 30, 2019 as presented. 2 ayes. Motion carried.

Jake Hotchkiss, Engineer and Office Manager Jelen McCall gave the weekly update. Board reviewed permits underground utility for new service for Windstream and sanitary outlet on Nebraska Ave. Road maintenance May 27th thru May 31st. Monday was a holiday, Territory Operators were in their blades 3 days, continued mowing shoulders and worked on signs. Seeded spots from culvert projects and installed crossroad pipe on Benton Ave. Wednesday received 2-4 inches of rain overnight, several roads were closed Tuesday night, continued closing roads, set up a flagger on J20 in order to keep road open to public and repairing damage where we could while waiting for water to go down. Worked on reclaiming rock that washed off roads and hauling rock to repair wash outs, repaired a washout on Franklin Ave. W55 Franklin Ave Bridge is closed and the contractor has set up erosion control and will be moving equipment in this week. J20 Bridge Project by Lowell closure is delayed due to river levels. 310th St from New London Rd to Marsh Ave is closed due to an active slide. Contract rock haul with River Products is complete as of yesterday and we started up with Douds today up around the Wayland area. Flood 2019 we are documenting damage currently and taking pictures and doing repairs as we go for the potential of a declaration. We had several flash flood locations and then dealt with the Skunk River, Crooked Creek, Cedar Creek and Big Creek all had significant flooding.

Kelly Carr was present and informed the Board that she had quotes on the equipment and installation of the automatic doors at the county building of Public Health and Community Services. The Board informed her that it would go back on the agenda Thursday to bring off the table and take action on.
