

## **In response to the COVID-19 Disaster:**

The **Henry County Courthouse** is closed to the public effective March 17, 2020 until further notice. The courthouse staff including the treasurer's office are here and working to serve you. **Please call 319-385-0763 or email [treasurer@henrycountyiowa.us](mailto:treasurer@henrycountyiowa.us) for assistance.** Our mailing address is **Henry County Treasurer, P O Box 146, Mt Pleasant, IA 52641.**

**DRIVER LICENSE** services are not available through the Henry County Treasurer's Office. Iowa DOT Service Centers are open on an appointment only basis and only for essential services until May 1. You may be able to renew your driver license online at: <https://iowadot.gov/mvd/driverslicense/renew>. You do have a 60-day grace period. Any concerns about getting a Real Id should wait as the enforcement of Real ID will not happen until October 2020.

**Please note: In response to the COVID-19 outbreak and Iowa Gov. Kim Reynolds issuance of a State of Public Health Disaster Emergency, if your driver's license has an expiration date of January 16, 2020 or later you do not have to renew your license currently. It will remain valid for driving purposes until the declared disaster has ended.**

**MOTOR VEHICLE** services are available through our office. Registration renewals can be processed by visiting the website shown on your renewal notice and using a plate number and the provided PIN. You also can renew your registration by mailing your notice and check payable to Henry County Treasurer. A drop box is located near the South courthouse door for your convenience to leave your renewal payment in an envelope with your notice. Your application for vehicle renewal will be received and processed by this office and mailed to you promptly. Title transfers can be processed but will require you to phone us to enable the transfer.

**Please note: In response to the COVID-19 outbreak and Iowa Gov. Kim Reynolds issuance of a State of Public Health Disaster Emergency, if your vehicle registration expired January 16, 2020 or later it will be considered valid until the declared disaster has ended.**

**If you are purchasing or transferring a vehicle you will not be required to obtain a title and registration within 30 days. This will remain in effect until the declared disaster has ended.**

**PROPERTY TAX** payments can be made either online at the website listed on your tax statement, by mail or dropped in the courthouse drop box. Online is easy to do and if paying by e-check there is a low 25 cent convenience fee. You will be able to print a receipt for your records. Please be sure to include a phone number with your mailed or drop box payment. If you are paying both motor vehicle and property tax you must use separate checks.

**Please note: In response to the COVID-19 outbreak and Iowa Gov. Kim Reynolds issuance of a State of Public Health Disaster Emergency, tax payment penalty and interest will not be imposed until April 16, 2020.**

**COURTHOUSE DROP BOX INSTRUCTIONS: NO CASH – Place your items in an envelope and include contact information including your telephone number.**
